## You Will Need:

- LAMINATED TACO CARDS
- DRY ERASE MARKER
- ERASER
- DRAGON PUPPET

## To Play:

DETERMINE THE CHILD'S SKILL LEVEL BEFORE BEGINNING. WHAT LETTERS  
ARE THEY WORKING ON? WHAT SIGHT WORDS ARE THEY TRYING TO  
MASTER? USE 9 OF THOSE LETTERS OR WORDS FOR THIS ACTIVITY.

ON EACH CARD, WRITE ONE OF THE LETTERS/WORDS. YOU CAN USE THEM AS FLASHCARDS, PLACING ONE IN FRONT OF THE STUDENT SO THEY CAN LABEL IT, OR YOU CAN USE THEM AS SELECTIONS, PLACING 2-3 CARDS IN FRONT OF THE CHILD AND ASKING THEM TO FIND A SPECIFIC LETTER/WORD. WHEN THEY HAVE CORRECTLY IDENTIFIED THE WORD/LETTER, HAVE THEM LIFT IT TOWARDS THE DRAGON PUPPET AND USE THE PUPPET TO PRETEND TO GOBBLE IT UP (WITH A BIT OF THEIR HAND FOR SOME EXTRA GIGGLES AND FUN). NOM NOM NOM!
