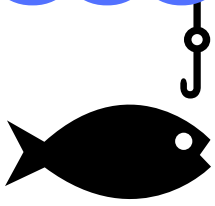


Fishin' Sight Word & Letter Game

PRINT THE FLASH CARDS, CUT THEM OUT, AND THEN LAMINATE THEM TO PREPARE FOR THIS READING ACTIVITY!



You Will Need:

- LAMINATED FISH FLASH CARDS
- DRY ERASE MARKER
- ERASER
- STICK OR ROLLED UP PIECE OF PAPER
- STRING
- PAPER CLIP

To Play:

DETERMINE THE CHILD'S SKILL LEVEL BEFORE BEGINNING. WHAT LETTERS ARE THEY WORKING ON? WHAT SIGHT WORDS ARE THEY TRYING TO MASTER? USE 9 OF THOSE LETTERS OR WORDS FOR THIS ACTIVITY.

ON EACH CARD, WRITE ONE OF THE LETTERS/WORDS. ROLL UP A PIECE OF PAPER TO ACT AS THE FISHING POLE, ATTACH SOME STRING AND THE PAPER CLIP (THE HOOK). HAVE THE STUDENT CAST THE FISHING LINE OVER THE EDGE OF A TABLE (OR ANY DIVIDER YOU HAVE ON HAND-- YOU CAN THROW A BLANKET OVER A CHAIR!), ATTACH ONE OF THE CARDS, HAVE THEM "REEL" IT IN, AND LET THE FUN BEGIN!
