

# Reading Lesson

## Reading Number Words

This lesson is designed to accompany a reading of the book "Olivia" by Ian Falconer  
Connection: Olivia LOVES it when her mom reads her stories at night. In the book she asks for 5 bedtime stories, but her mom says she will only read 3. We are going to practice our numbers so we can read and count like Olivia!

Objective: Match the number to the printed number word.

### Materials Needed:

- Number Cards (Print & Laminate)
- Number Word Cards (Print & Laminate)

### Instructions

- 1. Begin by fanning out the number cards and letting the child select one.
- 2. Ask the student to label the number
- 3. Place three number word cards on the table in front of the child (include the number they have in their hand).
- 4. Ask the student to find the number word that goes with the number they drew.
- 5. Continue with remaining numbers.
- 6. Reverse the cards. The child now draws a number word, reads the word, and then selects the number from three choices provided (or more, depending on their skill level).
