



MATHEMATICS LESSON

COUNTING & 1:1 CORRESPONDENCE

Note: This lesson is designed to accompany a reading of the book "Don't Let the Pigeon Drive the Bus" by Mo Willems
Connection: The Pigeon in this book really wants us to let him drive the bus, but the bus driver said he is not allowed!
We probably aren't big enough to drive a bus either, but we can drive toy cars! Let's practice our parking skills while we count our numbers!

Objective: Identify the written number and park the corresponding number of cars in the parking lot!

MATERIALS NEEDED:

- 9 Toy Cars
- Parking lot Mat, laminated
- Expo Marker
- Eraser

INSTRUCTIONS:

- 1. Write a number in the stop sign at the top left corner of the sheet
- 2. Ask the child to identify the number
- 3. Invite the child to park the corresponding number of cars while counting out loud! (ex. if the number is 3, they should park 3 cars in the lot)
