

Reading Lesson

Sight Words & Letter Sounds

This lesson is designed to accompany a reading of the book "The Big Hungry Bear" by Don & Audrey Wood. Connection: This little story is about a little mouse who tries to hide his strawberry from the big, hungry bear! We are going to play a game where YOU try to hide a strawberry from ME. I will be the big hungry bear!

Objective: Give letter sounds OR read sight or CVC words

Materials Needed:

- Strawberry Cards (Cut and Laminated)
- Dry Erase Marker
- Bear Puppet (We used a brown sock puppet and just glued on googly eyes)

Instructions

1. On each strawberry card, write letters or words the child is working on
2. Lay the cards face down on the table
3. Tell the child to select a card, read it, then hide it (between hands, under chair, under table, etc.)
4. If they read it correctly, use the puppet to act out searching for the strawberry, then when you find it, gobble up the strawberry and enjoy the giggles!
5. Switch roles, but have the child read the strawberry before you hide it.
